SEL SUPPORT DURING THE LOCK DOWN

“When the going gets tough, the tough get going!”

The year 2020 began like any other new year. Things seemed as normal as any other new year, with all of us, both at SEL and SEL Schools, gearing up for the last quarter of the year, preparing for final assessments, examinations and getting report cards ready.

When right out of almost nowhere one tiny unknown virus created panic like never seen before, at least not in the lifetime of most people alive on earth today!



Novel Corona Virus – or COVID-19 as it is also known as caught all of us on the blind side. From being something unknown it grew to become a pandemic that had the world gripped in fear and uncertainty.

However, even when the country went into lock down, SEL and our Shri Educators did not! They toiled unceasingly to ensure that LEARNING does not stop.

The first and toughest task was to equip our teachers in the various schools, in both metros and two/three tier cities, with the technical skills required to navigate through the various online tools and platforms that were available for use. Forced out of their comfort zones, teachers faced innumerable difficulties, especially with network and bandwidth, but the IT Team at SEL forged on, working round the clock to make the transition as easy and seamless as possible for our Shri Educators.



VIRTUAL TRAINING DONE BY IT

Online trainings were conducted for MS TEAMS, ZOOM, ZOHO Webinars, Padlet, Wakelet, Quizlet, Canva, Edpuzzle, Kahoot, Socrative, Wizer.me, Rocketbooks, Quizziz and Flipgrid. Assignments could be sent home because our Educators quickly grasped the advantages of using Microsoft/Google forms as both home assignments and for assessments. Optimising the use of PPTs by converting them into videos for self-learning and online teaching was another thing that they were given training on. Trainings were done to familiarise them with other online resources such as Interactive Worksheets, VideoScribe, Inshot and so on.

Sessions by the ICT Domain experts at SEL were conducted where other aspects of Online Teaching-Learning were further strengthened. Some of the sessions conducted are – MS TEAMS – Class NoteBook, Gamify Your Classroom, Amplify Student Voice with FlipGrid and De-mystifying AI.

While, technology was the need of the hour, strengthening teacher capability and competency for online teaching was an area that the Subject Domain experts at SEL worked on along with their subject teachers across schools.

The OPS TEAM redesigned their workshop modules and customised them to help teachers gain the most out of an online workshop or teaching session. A common group was formed on TEAMS and WhatsApp which worked like a Help Desk and also a platform for teachers to share ideas with each other.

This fostered collaboration across school teams at all levels. It also ensured that quick and speedy responses were given to queries or issues that were raised, thereby helping in a small way to reduce their stress and anxiety.

A sudden change to our everyday lives, tough times and a unique set of challenges presented us with the need to stay connected. A need, that could not be fulfilled in a physical space. Rightly said, "Necessity is the mother of invention", - Plato

An online platform, we call "Hamaara Aasmaan" came into being to engage with learners in a joyful, nurturing and progressive environment, with a twist! The launch of this platform was a step towards putting together fun based, yet meaningful, activities that can be done by parents along with their child at home.

Keeping the attention span of our pre-schoolers in mind and also to maintain the essence of our philosophy, was an uphill task but we surely have overcome that obstacle.

Short sessions every day allowed us to connect with our little ones, which was what thoroughly missed. Tailor made modules have been specially created in house keeping in mind the needs and capabilities of our little children.

A healthy mixture of live sessions, pre-recorded co-curricular activities, social interaction time and one-on-one attention meetings have been planned for the term. Tale Times, E-Yoga, Smiling Minds, Art Box, Busy Fingers, Krazy Kitchens, Brain Gym are just a few of the activities planned for the online module.

The Lock Down also triggered another interesting and engaging initiative at SEL. "Shri Kathayein – Story Telling Sessions with Happy Hippo" became a "must watch" Sunday evening event for our children and parents alike. While it began with teachers from TSEY Gurugram being the vibrant story tellers, our Shri Educators from partner schools also stepped in to keep our children and parents enthralled. Airing at 5.30 p.m. every Sunday, this series will continue to roll out so that all SEL schools collaborate and connect to sustain the programme.

A new experience for all of us, it gave us the opportunity to explore all available options and discover what we are truly capable of.

Team SEL pitched in, going the extra mile and working round the clock to ensure that Learning Never Stops – for All!



SEL's Marketing Team worked along with the school teams to further strengthen the three-way handshake by increasing schools' visibility through several digital media campaigns. The virtual classes conducted by TSEY was made available to all our Consultancy Preschools, as was the 4-week Virtual Summer Camp.

Facebook Live Sessions were conducted for schools to enable them to reach out to parents who were as concerned and stressed out as a result of the sudden and unprecedented turn of events.

Where work-life balance was a concern earlier, a third aspect loomed up – their children's learning. To support and guide them in this area, sessions such as Cyber Security, Shri Samvaad, Parenting During the Pandemic, Understanding the ABCs of the Lockdown (and its impact on children), Understanding the Needs of Children, etc. were conducted for parents.

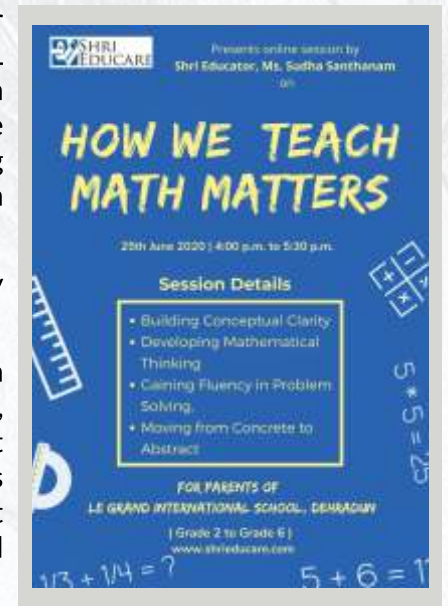
SEL experts also conducted workshops for parents to help them understand the Shri Way of Learning so that they can guide their children during this forced home schooling period. Needless to say, these were a great success, with parents asking for more sessions of this nature.



Another new initiative by SEL were the collaborative trainings done to encourage peer learning amongst teachers. Domain experts from SEL along with the Teachers from SEL schools conducted workshops on a common platform. Some of the sessions conducted were Mathematics – The Vedic Way; Akshar Gyan; Dealing With Abstract Concepts; Building Online Research Skills; Understanding the Needs of Children.

The parent session done for the Student Advisory Programme was much appreciated.

On the cards are more of these sessions, for both teachers and parents, will be rolled out periodically, to ensure that teachers, students and parents benefit from them. Video Recordings based on concepts across subjects and grade levels are being created at SEL by the Domain experts and these will be shared with the school as and when they get ready.

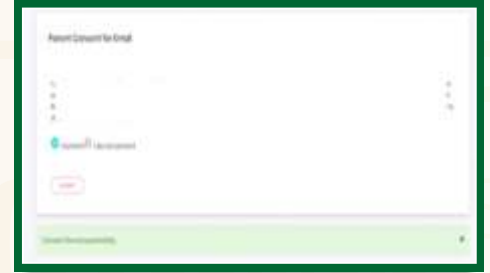
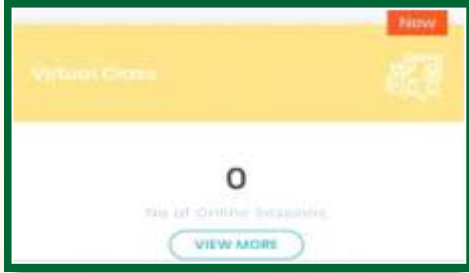


During these unprecedented times, we at SEL have been working diligently to help school teams maintain school operations seamlessly, as they adapt to the new demands during the pandemic and adopt new skills and tools to enable their work.

We realized school operations must go on, therefore, we compiled all the support and resources available to enable digital transformation through ShriConnect.

This quarter we released the following updates on ShriConnect:

- Virtual Class Module:** Teachers can now record the lessons or create the lesson schedule on Zoom/Team classes and upload the link onto ShriConnect. Parent receive a notification on their mobile app and web portal. There is also a provision/option wherein the school can get parent consent also digitally.



- ShriConnect FMS 2.0.0:** Via this option, Parents can pay single quarter's or entire year's fee. This option was provided to give parents a discount if payment is made for the whole year. Cashfree PG service for Card and Cradles EMI option was also created and provided to schools. There is also an option for part payment of the regular and admission fees.
- Mark trends and analysis:** Various Mark analysis of students is another new feature available on the Parent Portal and SMT Portal.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAMME

The pandemic and the lockdown though hard, has in fact come as a blessing in disguise. It has opened us up to new avenues and methods of learning like never before. With social distancing, we are connecting & collaborating more and more through online mediums.

In light of the situation, Shri Educare Limited and Ghiyasuddin International School have jointly launched a Community Outreach Program at GIS, Maldives.

This program has two main phases: a teacher outreach and a parent outreach. ‘A Window into the Classroom’ is a virtual lesson walkthrough for teachers of all SEL partner schools hosted by the teachers of the Ghiyasuddin International School, Maldives.

They opened up their classes to their colleagues and it has been a rich learning experience for everyone involved. Till now there have been 10 virtual lesson walkthroughs with 193 attendees in total.

The parent outreach program started on 25th June 2020 and would host 9 webinars till 6th of August. With presenters from India, Maldives and USA, the webinars are being conducted through Zoom and are also going live on Facebook. In the sessions till now, we had a total of 67 attendees for the first session, 70 for the second and 102 for the third session.
