विषय: School Quality Assessment & Assurance Framework (SQAAF) के पोर्टल पर Self-Learning संसाधन की उपलब्धता

परिपत्र संख्या 14/2023 दिनांक 24.03.2023 द्वारा शैक्षणिक सत्र 2024-25 से SARAS पोर्टल पर नई संबद्धता / स्विच-ओवर/अपग्रेडेशन/विस्तार के लिए आवेदन स्वीकार करने के लिए CBSE द्वारा SQAAF के अनुसार पूर्व स्व-मूल्यांकन अनिवार्य कर दिया गया है। इसके साथ ही उपर्युक्त परिपत्र के माध्यम से ही बोर्ड ने अपने सभी संबद्घ विद्यालयों को प्रत्येक वर्ष 1 अप्रैल से 31 दिसंबर के बीच SQAAF पोर्टल पर स्व-मूल्यांकन करने के लिए निर्देशित किया है।

विद्यालयों को प्रभावी तरीके से फ्रेमवर्क को लागू करने और निष्पक्ष रूप से स्व-मूल्यांकन करने में सक्षम बनाने के लिए, बोर्ड ऑनलाइन Self-Learning संसाधन विकसित कर रहा है, जिसका उपयोग विद्यालयों द्वारा SQAAF व इसके डोमेन और मानकों के बारे में समझ हासिल करने के लिए किया जा सकता है।

Sub: Availability of Self-Learning Material on School Quality Assessment & Assurance Framework (SQAAF) Portal

Vide Circular No. 14/2023 dated 24.03.2023, prior Self-Assessment as per the SQAAF has been made mandatory by CBSE for the acceptance of applications for fresh affiliation/switch-over/ upgradation/ extension on SARAS Portal for the academic session 2024-25 and onwards. Further, vide the above-mentioned circular, the Board has also mandated all its affiliated schools to undertake self-assessment on SQAAF Portal every year between 1st April to 31st December.

To enable the schools to implement the framework in an effective manner and undertake self-assessment objectively, the Board is developing online self-learning materials for the schools, which can be used to gain understanding about the SQAAF domains and standards.

The schools can access the following Online Self-learning modules under "Self-Learning Material" head visible after logging in the SQAAF Portal at https://saras.cbse.gov.in/sqaa:





Go to Login and 'Login as' menu and mouse over it and then click on 'School Login'.






The School can login into the system using **ANY ONE** of the following two options:

- Login into the system using cbseshiksha.in email


Enter your School login LOC credentials and sign in to SQAA Portal.

Enter cbseshiksha.in email to get OTP and sign in to SQAA Portal.






After login the following Dashboard screen will be visible.


